### Youth Report:

**CCC Report:** The club has nominated Bob and Katie Lenz for Horsemen of the Year. Next meeting there will be a bid for points keeper. It is a 3 year contract and you need to be able to show your ability to do the job. The 7CPHC show will be in April and will be Wed, Thurs, and Fri. The Brookside show needed more workers and it was hard on the kids. Other clubs are moving their show dates, so maybe we can move to their days. The 2 judge shows were fun! Motion by Linda to have a Labor Day show 2<sup>nd</sup> Carol.

**New Business:** Discussion about the sponsorship sheet. Need clarification on what exactly the bronze sponsors and the business card sponsors differences are. If there are any ideas for sponsorship stuff email Diane or bring your idea to the next meeting. This also includes rule changes!

**APHA Convention: Libby-** The World Show will be changed as follows: youth/am, Sr. Halter, and Solid Paint Bred classes will be in the summer. During the fall, approx. November 3-15 or so, will be Open, Jr. Pleasure and Futurities.

- For rule change proposals they changed it from 25 directors signatures to 51 signees.
- If you are suspended in another equine association (i.e. AQHA, PtHA, ApHC, etc.) you will also be suspended in APHA.
- If you would like to reserve a name, you may do so for \$100 for one year with written notice. If you do not use the name within one year it will be forfeited.
- HYPP and OLWS are not going to be printed on registration certificates under the requested rule. Reason being that one considered a genetic trait and the other is a disease. So they cannot both be under the same rule. They can be done as TWO rules though.
- SC045-Riders can only count 20 judges and only show under the primary judge two times.
- SC095-Add 2 stallion classes.
- SC110-Must line up and place in order 1-7. Riders may now be dismissed to a designated area to have placings read off.
- All judges must wear a long sleeved shirt.
- You must be an APHA member to show in an APHA class.
- In-hand trail will now be scored as regular trail with every obstacle having a point value.
- It is no longer required to band or braid your horses mane.
- HUS has new requirements. 2 beat gait, flat knees, and not quick strided.
- If you show in a two year old or 3 year old pleasure class you are NOT eligible to show in the Jr. Horse category at that show.
- APHA has added ranch sorting.
- APHA has added stock horse reining.

- Clerical errors have to be changed no later than one hour after the end of the show.
- The new name for breeding stock is Solid Paint Bred
- There will be no performance halter.
- You must be 16 years old to exhibit a stallion in an open class.
- Youth reining pattern #4 has been changed.
- APHA has added youth limited cow work.
- APHA has also approved novice youth limited cow work.
- Novice western riding and novice reining patterns stand alone.

There was also discussion about youth/amateur ownership. You cannot buy a horse and then show right away and then give the horse back. There is discussion on how long the waiting period should be. 30, 90, 365 days??

7CPHC received a letter from the American Paint Horse Foundation about donations for fundraisers.

**Zone Show:**

They are not giving the Zone show back. The Burbank show may not exist next year.
