Old Business:

Show Committee Report - April POR Update – Sally Jo Fran will replace Nicki Longacre, need one ring steward for Friday. Need people to set jumps and trail. Future discussion that our club members work 7CPHC show for qualifying hours. For this show, Diane Lang asked members to try to work our show.

Show Committee Report - July Youth/Am Update – Libby had sample premium for members to look at. Youth/Am judges – Cal Gomez, Floyd Danley, Don Bloomquist; 2-day show judges – Mike Hatchel and unknown. Motion by Nancy Fenn to hire Sharon Fincher and her friend to ring steward, 2nd by Libby – Passed. Cannot hold over a judge as previously discussed, therefore only looking at having 3 judge Youth/Am. Nancy motioned for a 2 judge open show and a 3 judge Youth/Am, 2nd by Carol Ray – Passed. Nancy wanted to get the word out to get hotel reservations early for King City show as that is the same weekend of mid-state fair. Carol Ray has 24 jump standards that club can borrow for King City show, Libby has poles. Libby needs volunteer to make photo back drop, John O'Hara will be photographer.

New Business:

Open Program – Yearling Lunge Line, 2 Show Requirement – Kristi Abrams and Debi Kent discussed the possibility of changing the two show minimum for yearlings and weanlings due to early dates of the shows and requested this discussion at the meeting. There was a lengthy discussion on the subject. Linda Tacklind also brought up that the rules say “attend” the show to qualify. Members decided that “attend” meant show. Discussion continued on possible rule change, Ed Flores stated that Robert's Rules of Order would not allow club to reopen the request to reopen the Open show rules to change the two show minimum.
